8 ORDINANCE NO. 2020 – 20 – 1J
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10 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FY 2020-21 BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING \$255,915
11 IN FEDERAL PASS-THROUGH GRANT FUNDING TO THE SPECIAL REVENUE
12 AND/OR CAPITAL PROJECTS FUNDS FOR THE ACQUISITION OF EMERGENCY
13 MANAGEMENT RELATED EQUIPMENT AND TRAINING

15 WHEREAS, The State of Alaska, Department of Military and Veterans Affairs,
16 through the Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management
17 (ADHS&EM), has passed through \$255,915 in U.S. Department of Homeland Security
18 (USDHS) funding to the Fairbanks North Star Borough (Borough) for the 2020 State
19 Homeland Security Grant Program (2020 SHSGP); and
20

21 WHEREAS, Funding for this program is intended to enhance the ability of
22 states, territories, and urban areas to train, equip, prepare for, prevent, and respond to
23 terrorist attacks and natural disasters; and
24

25 WHEREAS, The Borough has identified the need for additional hazardous
26 materials response equipment, to update the Borough Continuity of Operations Plan
27 (COOP), training and support for Volunteers in Policing, and to upgrade the Borough
28 network physical firewalls; and
29

30 WHEREAS, Preparedness, and more specifically the protection of critical
31 infrastructure, requires an ability to prevent and respond to cyber incidents, and
32 ADHS&EM strongly encourages preparedness grant subrecipients to assess their
33 cybersecurity risks. The Borough will use a portion of the grant funds to upgrade network
34 physical firewalls to protect electronic communications systems, data storage, vital
35 information, and services from cyberattacks.

37 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Assembly of the Fairbanks
38 North Star Borough:
39

40 . Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is not of a general and permanent
41 nature and shall not be codified.

42 Section 2. Acceptance of a Federal Pass-Through Grant Funding. The
43 Borough formally accepts \$255,915 in federal grant funding from USDHS, passed through
44 ADHS&EM, for the 2020 SHSGP.
45

46 Section 3. Special Revenue and/or Capital Projects Funds Appropriation.
47 The FY 2020-21 budget is hereby amended by appropriating \$255,915 to the Special
48 Revenue and/or Capital Projects Funds budgetary guideline entitled "2020 State
49 Homeland Security Grant" and by increasing estimated revenue from federal pass-
50 through grants by a like amount.
51

52 Section 4. Eligible Expenditure Period. Expenditures incurred within the
53 effective dates of the signed grant agreement are eligible for reimbursement.
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55 Section 5. Administrative Fee. The administrative fee for the 2020 State
56 Homeland Security Grant is waived in accordance with the grant agreement.
57

58 Section 6. Contingency. This appropriation is contingent upon the receipt
59 of a signed grant agreement with ADHS&EM.
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61 Section 7. Effective Date. This ordinance is effective at 5:00 p.m. on the
62 first Borough business day following its adoption.


