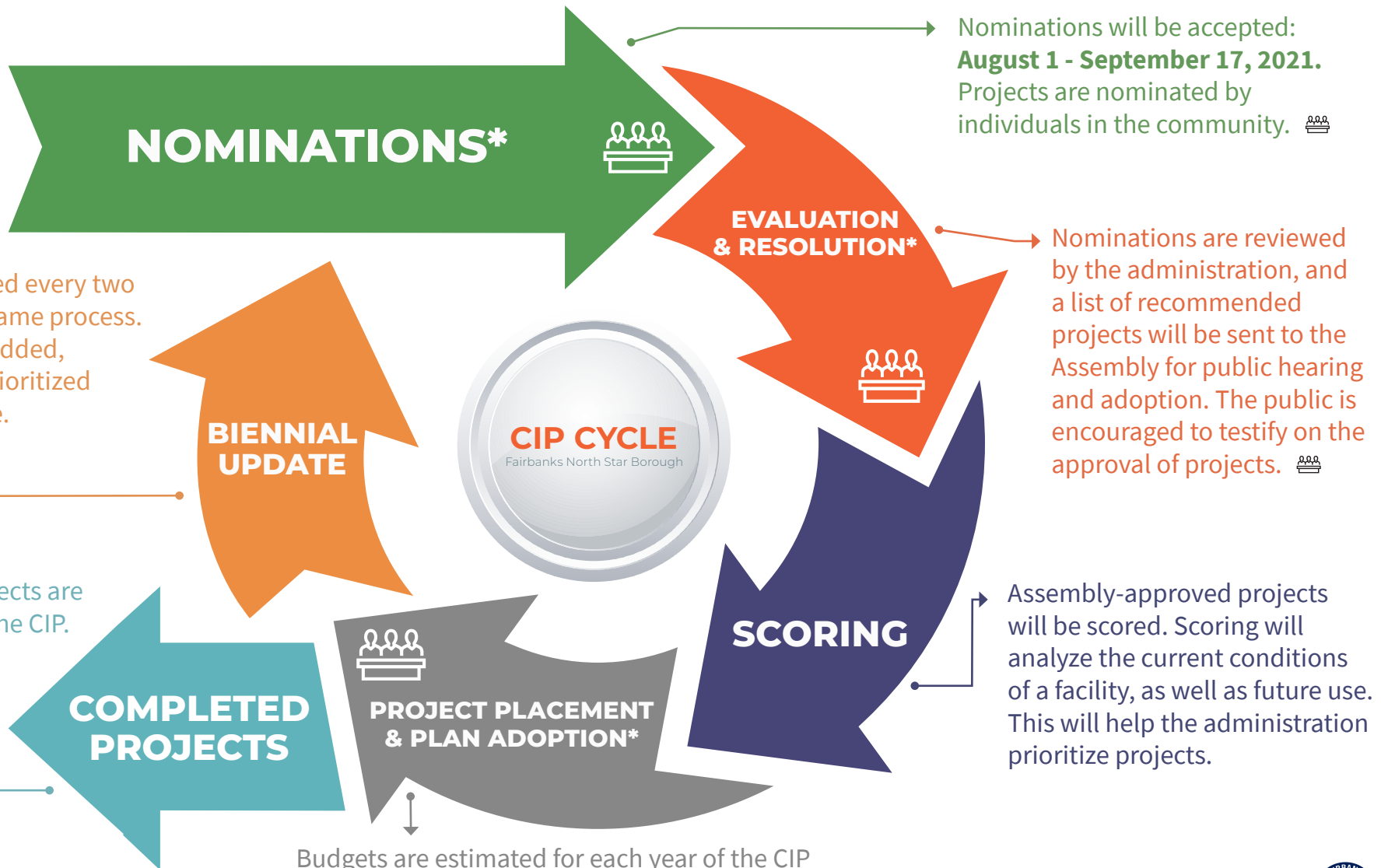


# CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (CIP): HOW IT WORKS

The CIP is designed as a multi-year capital plan for Borough infrastructure to provide a transparent process for project evaluation, prioritization, funding, and construction.



Nominations will be accepted: **August 1 - September 17, 2021.** Projects are nominated by individuals in the community. 🗳️

Nominations are reviewed by the administration, and a list of recommended projects will be sent to the Assembly for public hearing and adoption. The public is encouraged to testify on the approval of projects. 🗳️

Assembly-approved projects will be scored. Scoring will analyze the current conditions of a facility, as well as future use. This will help the administration prioritize projects.

Budgets are estimated for each year of the CIP and projects are broken into phases. The public is encouraged to testify on the completed plan. 🗳️

The CIP is updated every two years using the same process. Projects can be added, removed, or reprioritized during an update.

Completed projects are removed from the CIP.
